## Here's How It Works

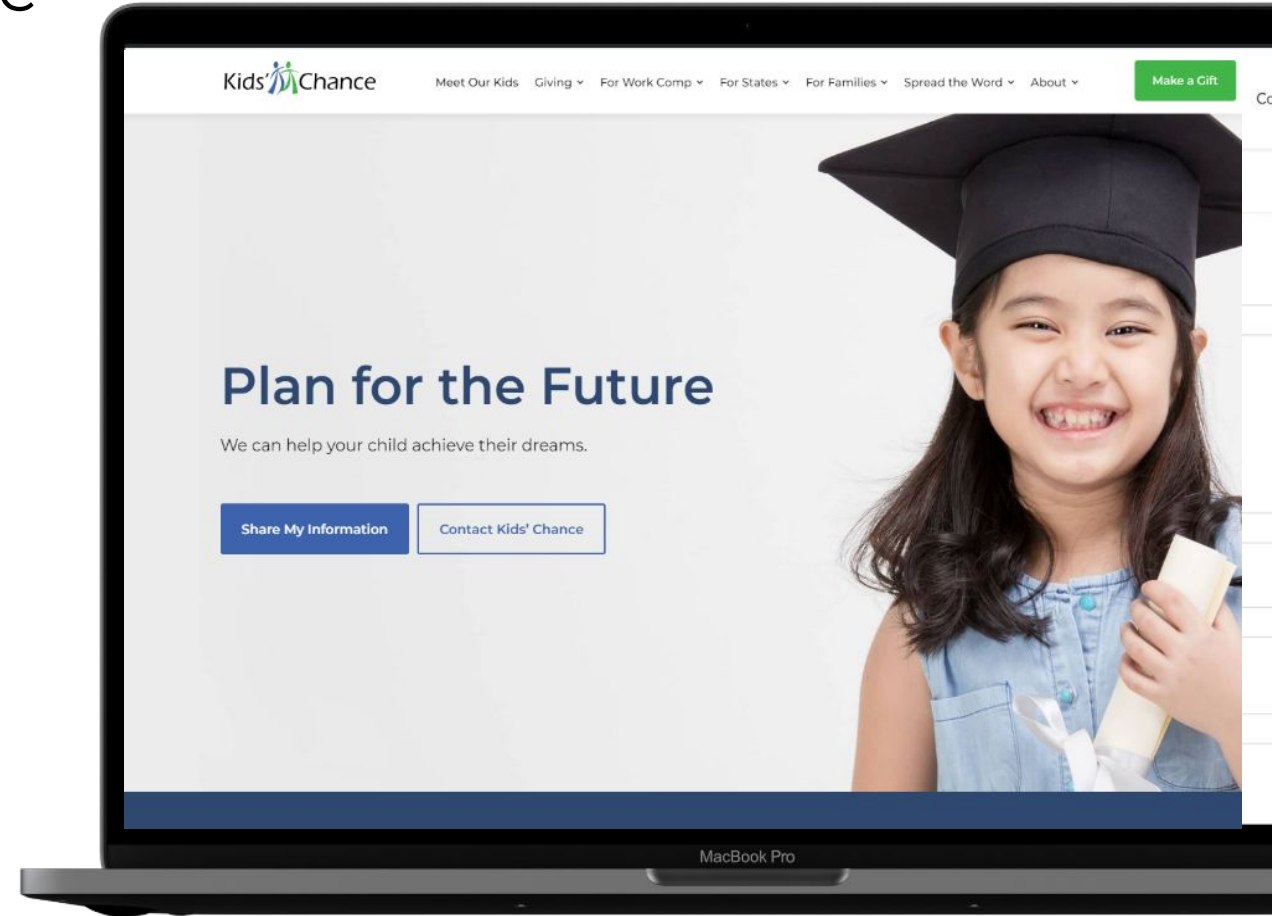
Jen is 6 years old.

work that paralyzed him.

Jen's mom visits the Kids' Chance of America (KCOA) website and goes to the Planning for the Future page.



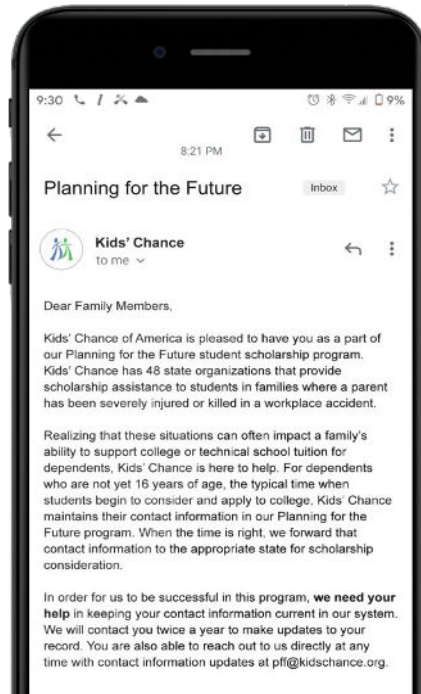
She fills out the online form.

Jen and her mom are now in our system.

Kids' Chance of America reaches out to Jen and her mom twice a year to keep their information up to date.



When Jen turns 16, KCOA **connects** her to the Kids' Chance chapter in the state where the claim was filed.



The state organization will then reaches out and encourages Jen to **apply for a scholarship.**
